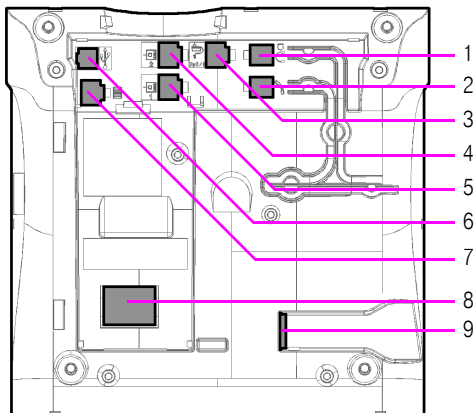

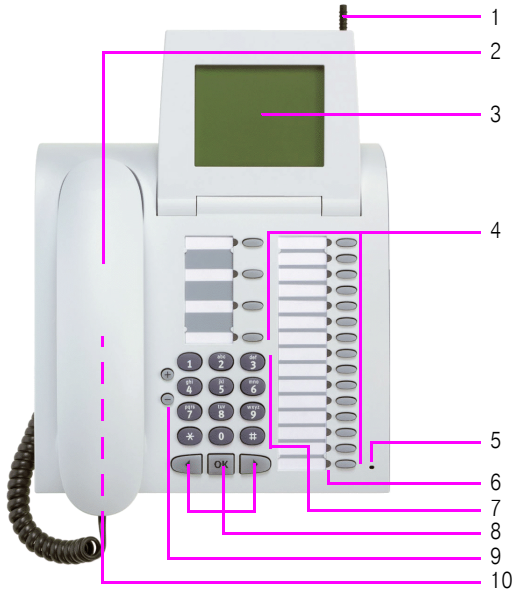

Step by Step

How to activate functions

... directly

Certain functions can be **selected directly in the idle state**, for example:


▶ OK

Make your selection with   and confirm it with .

OK
or

Other functions can be **selected directly in certain call situations**. You dial a number but the other party is busy:


▶ OK

Confirm with .

Make your selection with   confirm it with  and dial another number.

... via the Service Menu

First press the program/service key. You are then offered a number of selection options. Example: suppressing the number display at the called party:




Press the key.

Use the service code to switch to the Display Suppression function. The service codes are listed in the chapter „Functions and Codes“.

Press the key.

Make your selection with   and confirm it with .

▶ OK

... using a function key

You can activate directly a Hicom function that you have saved on a key, for example



Press the key. The function is executed.

... in local applications
